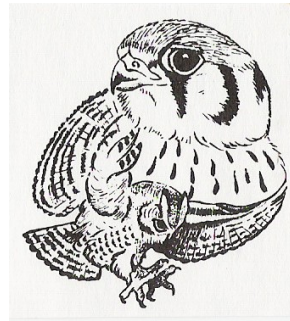




About the Speaker:
